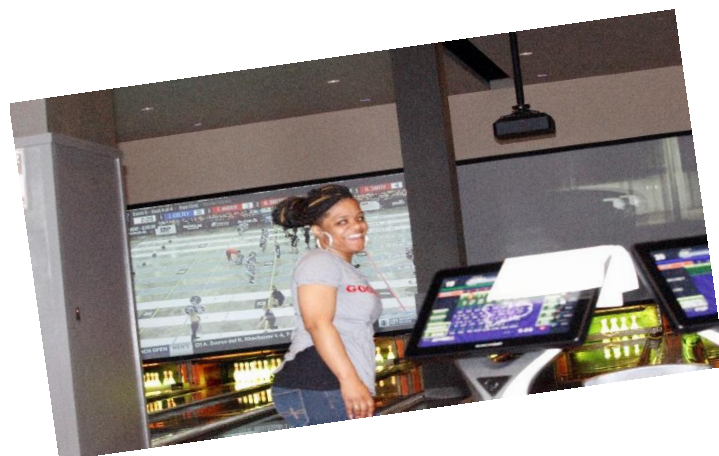

My Day in Muncie By Brother DeAngelo:

My name is Deangelo Gay, I recently was given an opportunity to witness a friend preach for the first time. It was an opportunity that steamed from an organization I am currently involved with. One of the partners of the organization asked if I wanted to come and share my story at Deliverance Temple, June 3rd. I had my reservations but I knew it was an opportunity to experience a friend at his best, So I accepted the invitation.

The morning of June 3rd, I was picked up by two older individuals whom I have never met. While we made our way towards the city, like any strangers stuck in the car together we started to make small talk. I was asked questions like "Who are you?" and "What are your

goals?". I could tell that my responses were not to their standards, although to my defense being in a car with two accomplished individuals can be intimidating.

Once we got to the church we found our chairs and I set back and watch the service begin. Walking into the building it was beautiful, clean, and smell free. Once the service began we went through the announcements and greeted the guest. G B. Rogers was introduced and began to speak about faith. Faith is a strong word for me because it was something I personally struggle with every day. He referred to Mark 11: 22-26:

22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. **23** For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. **24** Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive *them*, and ye shall have *them*. **25** And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. **26** But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

During the service, the minister decided to bring upon the stage guests. Guests who shared their stories of overcoming obstacles, being taken down, but overcoming challenges and adversities. Many of their stories stayed with me. I related to them; I found a connection because I too struggled with those same issues.

The minister then had me come upon the stage to show an example of how easy it is to be taken down and how hard it is to get back up. This also resonated with me because I am blessed to understand certain things easier than most. He had me stand up on stage and try to pull him on stage. In a flash, he jerked me off the stage. This action reminded me that no matter where you are, if you are not paying attention, someone or something can bring you down sooner than you think. I learned that no matter where I am, my faith can only be with God. God is the only shield that will protect me from the dangers of people and everyday life issues.

When the church service was over many of the visitors decided to eat out for lunch. I sat down and had a meal

with the same individuals who at first were intimidating but now inspiring. We talked about politics. I was informed on the views of the "other side". However, what I took from that conversation was more than views, it was an inspiration to move forward. It was the idea that you will never truly understand anything unless you take the chance and move forward. Taking risks and learning as you fail but not afraid to fail. But allowing God's words to polish your thinking and guide you through trying again. NEVER STOPPING.

Going to church on a consistent basis has taught me that the devil is only here to kill, steal, and destroy. However, listening to the Elder G. B. Rogers preach about faith taught me a valuable lesson. When combining both faith and the constant resistance the adversity one might face, faith in God, trust in God, in believing in God, will take you mentally, physically, and emotional, further than you could have ever imagined.

Signs, Miracles, and Wonders

Did you know that our prayers are answered even in the smallest of ways when we ask God to show up to confirm things in our lives? Caution, for non-believers this will be construed as coincidence; however, I always give God the praise and credit for answered prayers – no matter how big or small the request/answer.

Last week my partners and I had a meeting with a young lady regarding the possibility of merging some of our ministry endeavors together. She, Nikki Brown, is the founder of *Triumph Over Tragedy Ministries*. Her mission is to help primarily women that are in need to

get back on their feet. Our ministry is similar in dealing with men and women in the same type of capacity.

We had been contemplating the idea of expanding our mission when, by Divine appointment, we had the opportunity to meet Nikki several months ago. Over this time-period we began to find an enormous unity between the parties involved.

We scheduled a meeting at the Indianapolis Public Library to further discuss the plans for advancing forward. This meeting was scheduled for an hour because we had another lady joining us for the second hour. Her skills are related to grant writing; she and her daughter have written four books on grant writing, so we had a lot of faith in her skills and abilities.

When we went in to meet in the *East Reading Room* (the room typically used by the group), it was taken for an event. So, we went for the first time to the *West Reading Room*. We sat down and began to discuss the new mission.

As usual we prayed to start our meeting, and I asked that we would be given confirmation of our plans by signs, miracles, and wonders. God always answers! He is faithful!

One of the ministries our group plan to start is a Christian Motorcycle Ministry, *Soldiers of Salvation (SOS)*. We were also discussing ways to we deal with the discrimination of felons in today's society. I always use the comparison of the way MLK spoke of discrimination towards blacks, as he said in his day, negroes and African Americans, is the same way felons are discriminated against today. Statements like: you cannot live here; hiring – no felons need apply; felons not welcome, etc.

As we were discussing that subject my eyes were opened to many “signs” right in front of us. Keep in mind, we were sitting in a room we never used before and were directed there due to the room we would have commonly used was taken.

I looked up and there was a “sign” on the wall facing my table of Nikki Giovanni. I looked to the right of the sign and there was a “sign” of Adam Brown. All the books on the shelves were positioned the normal way and only one book was sitting at a 45-degree angle; its title is

SOS. And we are sitting in an area of the library that has the books related to discrimination of blacks.

Here I am meeting with Nikki Brown and we just discussed SOS and discrimination. I pointed this out to the group as a “sign” given to us by God. Then our grant writer, Cynthia, showed up during the second hour. I began to explain to her about the “signs” as I walked her to each of them that was clearly positioned around our meeting table.

When we got to the first “sign”, Cynthia said, “You will not believe this, but my first grandson is named Giovanni, and in addition to that, I myself am a felon from many years ago?”

So, you tell me, coincidence, or many “signs” from God through his miraculous and wonderous ways? We needed confirmation; God gave us our request immediately and suddenly. Still not sure as you read this testimony? Well, he gave us our 501(c)3 in only eight days! God is great and is always on time! Praise God and his Son, Jesus Christ forevermore. (I have pictures of these “signs” if you want to see them, just ask.)

Q & A

1-Q. Have you truly repented from the heart?

1-A. Repentance means to turn away from something that you are remorseful of. For example: If I mistreat you and say to you, "I'm sorry" but continually mistreat you, that's not true repentance. True repentance is saying I'm sorry for the action and not continually repeating it. If I steal from you and say that I'm sorry but continue to steal, I have not turned away from that

habit, I have not truly repented from my heart. If in my heart I am truly sorry but find myself continuing to do wrong, I myself may be controlled by something more than what appears to be surface, which means, I may need deliverance due to another source working through me in a manner that is now out of my control. If that is the case, thankfully we have a deliverance prayer in this edition by our own Prophetess Kenon on page 3. Pray and believe for your deliverance.



2-Q. What could be a sign that I need deliverance?

2-A. From experience: I had a horrible habit I truly wanted to stop. And I will emphasize, "I truly wanted to quit!" But no matter my heart's desire to be loosed, set free from this thing, I'd find myself back in the same ole boat. Now, looking from the outside, you would probably think, "Oh, she's just playing - she's not even trying - there she goes again, she's enjoying that." But there was a drive or a force that carried me; that took over when I wanted to stop. This thing/spirit began to control me, I was bound, merciless to this habit. I had fallen and I could not get up on my own. Instead of me having control over this habit, it now had control over my actions, over my thoughts, over my life. I was upset by it, but I could not quit/stop on my own. I needed deliverance and thank God, He is a Deliverer.

One of the deceits of the devil is to trap you. Don't drink the whole bottle, just a little at a time. Don't smoke the whole pack or the whole bag, but just a small portion at a time. So you start with that, feeding pleasures of the flesh and not long after that, you take just a little more, another drink, another puff and you put it down and here it comes

a few days/months later. A beautiful sunrise! This time, you say, "I'm going to quit that stuff, it's not good for me, I'm losing myself, it's tearing up my home, I need to quit, plus it's a little costly". But instead of you being able to stop, you find that you have no control. Something from the inside, another force and sometimes forces (friends - life situations) from the outside encouraging you to continue. The devil now has you many times hook, line and sinker. You say, "no" but

you still find yourself in the same predicament. Even upset and crying because you truly want to quit/stop that thing.

When you have no control over yourself, over your will, something else is in the driver's seat. One thing I understand about sin is a quote I heard many years ago: "Sin will keep you longer than you want to be kept and take you further than you wanted to go." (author unknown) If you find yourself needing deliverance, there's a deliverance prayer on pages 2 -3. The people will pray for you as well.

Now every habit is not sin. The bible says, in Hebrews 12:1b, "... let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us,..." If that habit has a seat in your life that outweighs your commitment to God and the things of God, you may want to reevaluate it to make sure of your allegiance. If by the spirit you get a call to pray, could you put that habit down and follow the leading of the Lord? Would you say, "I'll pray/fast/read later? Would you respond by saying, sure right after this movie/show is over or say, maybe tomorrow? The devil is subtle which is why the bible says, "Be watchful, be vigilant..."

What's Cooking?

Banana Bread

1 (8 oz pkg) Philadelphia Cream Cheese

1 C Sugar ¼ C Margarine

1 C Mashed Ripe Banana

2 Eggs 2 1/3 C Flour 1 ½ t Baking Powder

1/2 t Baking Soda

1 C Chopped Nuts (optional)

Combine cream cheese, sugar and margarine.

(mix well till blended)

Add remaining ingredients mixing until moistened. Pour into greased and floured, 9x5 inch loaf pan and bake at 350 deg., for 1 hour and 5 mins. Test to make sure it's baked completely using a clean butter knife or tooth pick. If the butter knife/tooth pick comes out clean, the bread is ready to come out of the oven. Let cool for about 6 minutes and remove from the pan. You can accent with a banana glaze.
